## The Matching Grant Program helps New Americans, through:









**If you qualify, you can receive cash assistance and services for up to six months.** Funded by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Service's Office of Refugee Resettlement, the Matching Grant program is an alternative to public cash benefits, designed to help newcomers become economically self-sufficient as quickly as possible. While in the Matching Grant program you may apply for other benefits, such as food stamps and Medicaid.

## Eligible individuals include:

- Asylees
- Certified victims of trafficking
- Refugees
- Special Immigrant Visa holders (SIVs)
- Cuban and Haitian entrants

You must apply for this program within 31 days of receiving documentation of status.
