- Accepts Medicaid, Medicare, Point Comfort Underwriters (Refugee Medical Assistance) and private insurance
- For uninsured, sliding scale is based on household income and household size

- The Wellness Center partners with the Alliance Language Network to accommodate over 80 languages with prior arrangement

Eligibility Requirements:

- Accepts most major health insurance plans including ACA Marketplace, CHIP, Medicare, Medicaid, and PCU (Refugee Medical Assistance)
- For uninsured, sliding scale is based on household income and household size

- Services for domestic violence survivors, sexual assault and childhood sexual abuse survivors include:
 - a. Group counseling—Offered on weekdays, evenings, and Saturdays in English and Spanish
 - b. Individual counseling—Available on a limited basis
 - c. Community based counseling and advocacy for individuals with disabilities
 - d. Provides resources and referrals
- Provides children and youth counseling services to victims of domestic violence or sexual abuse
- Provides 24-hour hotlines:
 - a. Domestic Violence Hotline: 713-528-2121
 - b. Sexual Assault Hotline: 713-528-7273

Eligibility Requirements:

- Services are confidential, free and available to all survivors, regardless of their race, country of origin, language, sex, gender identity, sexual orientation, or disability

INTENSIVE OUTPATIENT PROGRAM (IOP)

*The IOP is jointly run by Harris Health, Ben Taub, Hospital, and Baylor College of Medicine, Department of Psychiatry and Behavioral Sciences

Hours of Operation:

- Monday – Friday: 8:00 am – 5:00pm
- Group Schedules: Monday, Wednesday, Friday: 8:00 am – 12:00 pm

Type of Assistance:

- Provides intensive group and individual therapy programs for adults (18+) who acutely require a higher level of care than standard outpatient visits but do not require inpatient hospitalization
- Duration of treatment is usually ten weeks and includes the following:
 - a. Individual and group psychotherapy
 - b. Medication management
 - c. Case management

Eligibility Requirements:

- Individuals are required to be over 18 years of age and have stable housing and a form of transportation to and from the program
- Be willing to abstain from illicit drug and alcohol use for the duration of the program
- Open to all individuals within Harris County regardless of their financial status
- For individuals outside of Harris County, eligibility depends on insurance coverage
